We are delighted to share that this year's Christmas Memorial Service raised a total of £166.96. This money was donated to St. Luke's Hospice and including the money raised from the metal recycling scheme, we have raised a total of £4177.48 for them in 2018.

The 2018 metal recycling scheme also saw us being able to donate £3000 to The Love of Lydia and £1000 for The Joshua Tree.

A grand total of £8177.48 was raised, which would not have been achievable without the consent of the families that have to use our services
